### **I. SCOPE**

This policy applies to all members of the Frewsburg Fire District as it pertains to response to motor vehicle accidents. This policy shall be adhered to at all times.

### **II. PURPOSE**

It is the intent of this policy to make clear the apparatus response order and staffing of apparatus for the report of a vehicle accident.

### **III. PROCEDURE**

When an alarm is received reporting a motor vehicle accident with or without injuries, Frewsburg Fire District members shall adhere to the following operational procedures:

1. Respond to the fire hall and don full personal protective equipment.
2. A-341 shall respond with a driver and minimum of one EMT.
3. E-341 shall respond (unless a Chief Officer directs otherwise) with a driver / operator and a minimum of one firefighter for vehicle extrication.
4. The engine shall respond and position appropriately on the roadway for the incident considering the location of the accident. Engine shall be used as a blocker to protect on-scene personnel.
5. Fire police shall respond with M-341 if available. They shall stop traffic from both directions, if necessary, until an alternative route can be established.

### **\* NOTE \***

All responding personnel shall adhere to the Response Order SOP (7-01) posted at Station #1
