I. SCOPE

This policy applies to all Frewsburg Fire District members and shall be adhered to at all times.

II. PURPOSE

It is the intent of this policy to make clear the apparatus response order and minimum staffing of apparatus for the report of a brush fire.

III. PROCEDURE

When an alarm is received reporting a Brush fire, FFC members shall adhere to the following operational procedures:

- 1. Respond to the fire hall and don proper personal protective equipment.
- 2. First due apparatus (E-341) shall be minimally staffed by a qualified driver / operator, and one interior firefighter.
- 3. First engine on scene shall position appropriately on the roadway for the incident considering the location of the brush fire. Fire Police shall control traffic from either direction.
- 4. Second due engine (E-342) shall respond to the fire scene minimally staffed with a qualified driver / operator and one firefighter to establish an appropriate water supply for the attack engine if needed.
- 5. M-341 with Indian water tanks shall stage with first due engine.
- 6. A-341 shall respond to the scene minimally staffed with a qualified driver and an EMT to be used for rehab.

All responding personnel shall adhere to the Response order SOP posted at Station #1
