MONTHLY MEETING

Ed Nazario opened the meeting with the pledge to the flag

Secretary's report was read and bills were approved: motion by Don Sparling, and seconded by Bob Price

Credit Card Policy: The credit card policy was read and there are changes that have to be made. Add line that says chiefs can have a credit card. Discussed taking Ed's name off the credit card and put Justin's on his with a \$2,000 credit limit. Motion was made by Ed and seconded by Don Sparling.

CHIEF'S REPORT:

Nick will send an email to Dennis Brooks to find out what the insurance says about physicals, driver training.

Interior fire fighters should have their physical in September with Occu Star or another Occu Star date for a physical. Occupational Health is another place to have your physical. Exterior fire fighters can have their physical from their primary physician. They should have their physician sign off on a form the fire department will have made up with different things an exterior fire fighter does. Fire personnel will have until December 31st to get there physical done.

Life members are inactive until they get there physical and OSHA training done.

We discussed that if you have been on administrative leave for two years and have not done your physical or OSHA training chiefs will evaluate the situation. This was tabled until next meeting.

Discussion on the OSHA training in February – if not done then you will have to have it done by June 1st. You can also do this on line. This was tabled till next meeting.

Charlie – tracks are off the Kubota. Cannot buy replacement tracks for it. The wheels are back on it. There will be training on the Kubota. If you are not trained on it then you cannot drive it. Can replace the ATV & tracks for \$31,000. Dale does a lot of maintenance on the Kubota for free. A thank you note will be sent.

EMS billing – CON was approved to go to the district. We will be doing the billing through the county. Justin will be moved to be the CEO. Phil will be the interim for the narcotics.

\$35 will be billed per chart – 85% will come to us – 15% goes to the county. If Alstar transports we will not see a bill. If an Alstar member rides on our ambulance we will get a bill.

We received a letter from south valley that we can come to their meeting on July 19th to discuss a contract with them for next year.

The new cascade system will go where the refrigerator is.
